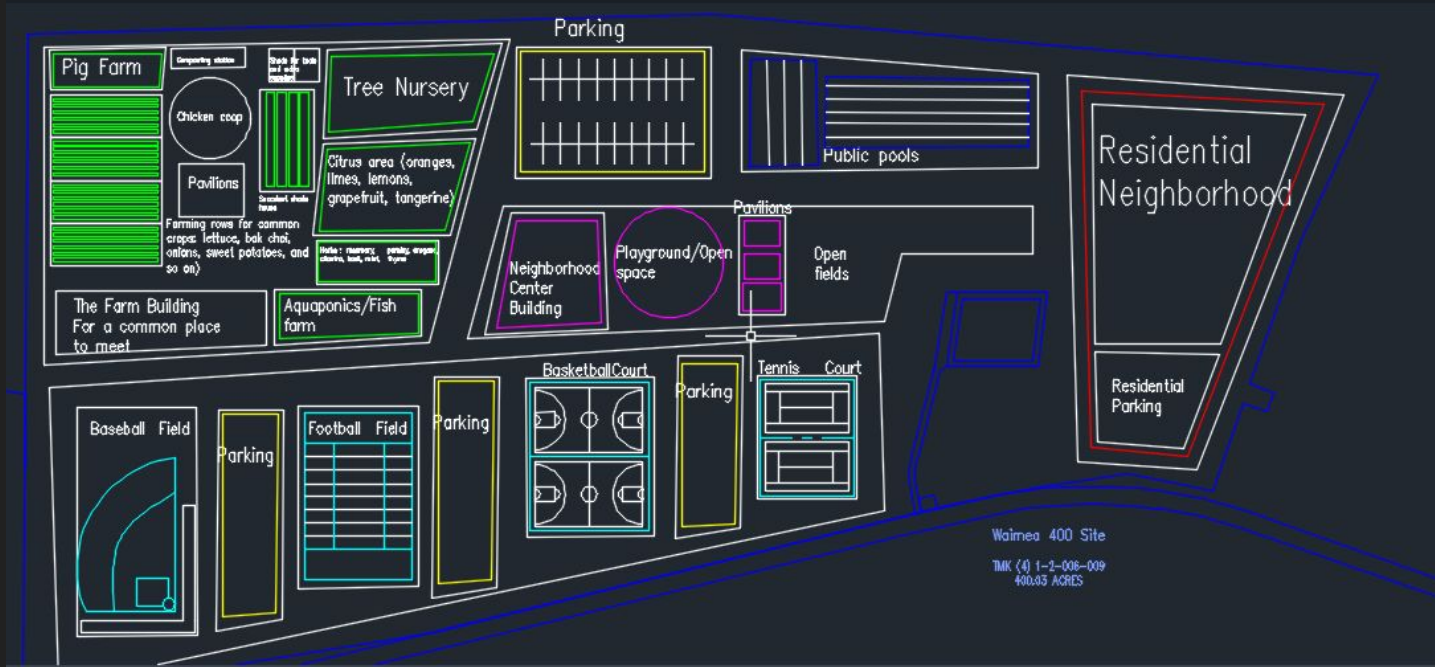
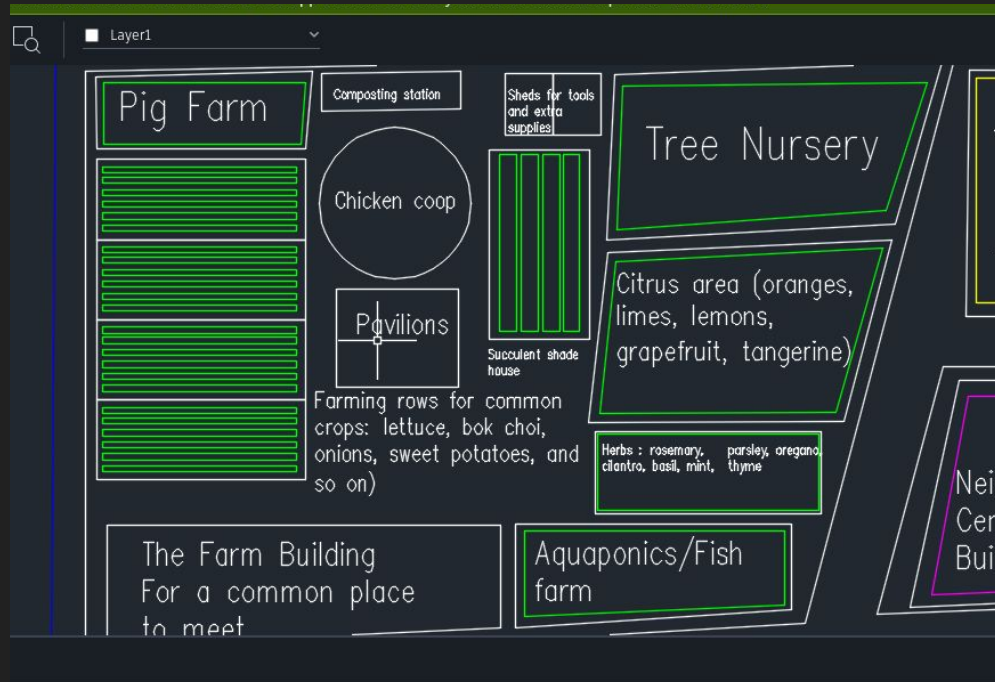


Individual Waimea 400 Project

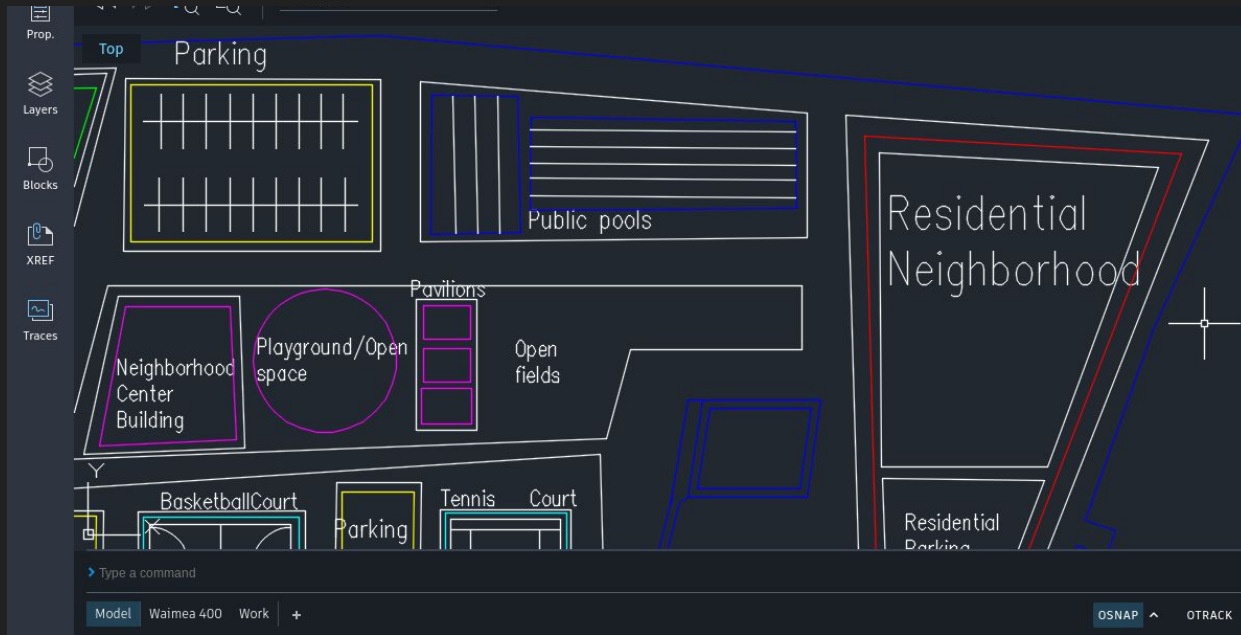

In my design there are residential housings, public pools, baseball and football fields, a basketball and tennis courts, a park, and a large community farm.

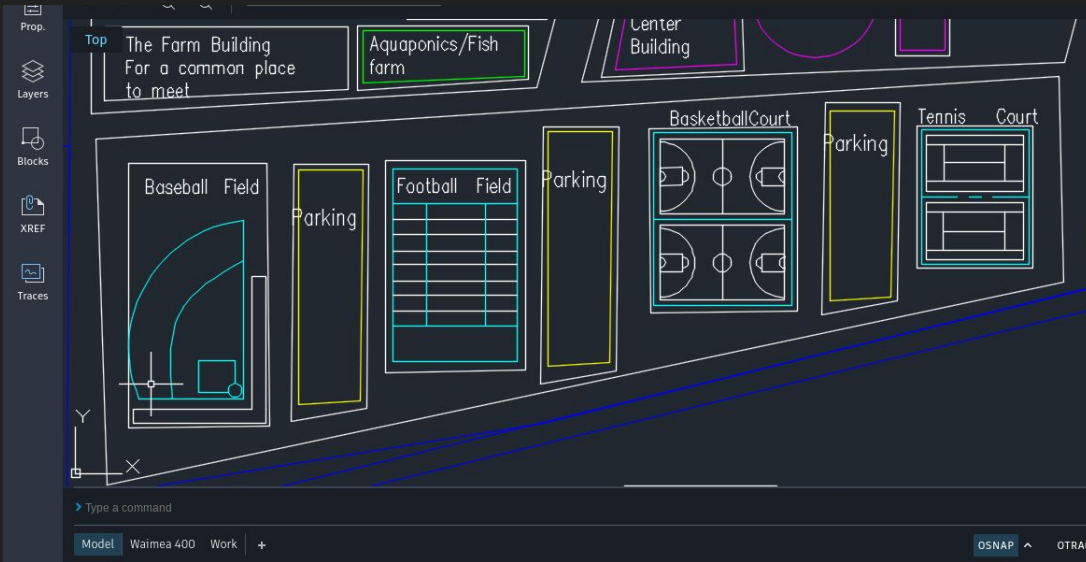
